



# RULES & REGULATIONS

THURSDAY MEN'S TWILIGHT  
12th January – 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2012

Clubs participating in HACT social competitions agree to participate in the spirit of good will and fairness, encouraging participation and fostering cooperation.

1. Women who participate in this competition should be at least fourth grade standard.
2. Games in this competition are two, thirty five minute halves, played on a Thursday evening with timeslots between 6.00 pm and 10.00 pm.
3. Finals will be played in Week 7 of the competition.
4. Games will be played in accordance with the F.I.H. "Rules of Hockey".
5. Each team must have a goalkeeper on the field at all times and this person MUST wear a helmet (the helmet must be supplied by the team). If teams do not play a goal keeper with the required protective gear they will forfeit the match.
6. The standard of this competition is roughly equivalent to the Midweek/Friday Men's winter competition.
7. Weekly team fees (\$110, GST inclusive) must be paid IN **FULL** to the Ground Manager prior to the start of the game. **NO PAY, NO PLAY.**
8. Team lists need to be marked off with the Ground Manager each game.
9. **A NON REFUNDABLE nomination fee of \$150** must be paid with submission of this form. Nominations will not be accepted without the nomination fee.
10. Each team must supply one umpire each week they play. Umpires will be rostered to umpire the game either before or after they play. Failure to supply an umpire for any rostered commitment will result in a \$35 fine payable on the night. The team will not be allowed to take the field the following week if this is not paid.
11. Games MUST start on time – any delays will result in the match being shortened.
12. Forfeits must be notified in writing to the Competitions Coordinator at Hockey ACT by 5.00pm on the Monday prior to the match otherwise the full weekly team fee will be charged.
13. A ladder will be kept for this competition this year – at the end of the season, bar tab prizes will be awarded to teams as follows

1st \$100  
2nd \$ 80  
3rd \$ 60  
4th \$ 50  
All others \$ 30

The Competitions Coordinator has the power to apply a penalty to teams or individual/s within a team for any breach of these rules. Penalty may include a warning, fine, loss of points and with regards to consistent and serious breaches expulsion from the competition.

Any contingencies not provided for in these rules shall be decided by the Competitions Coordinator
